



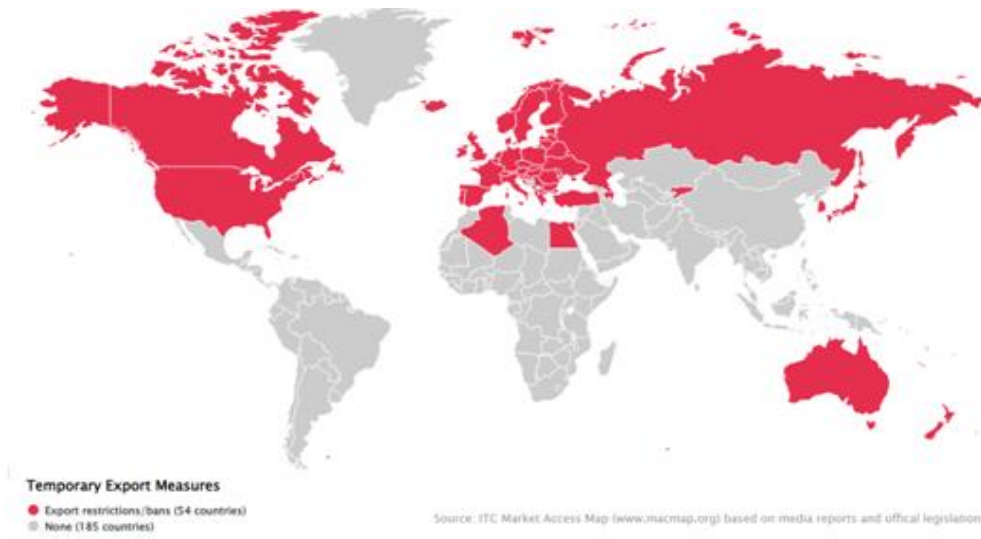

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

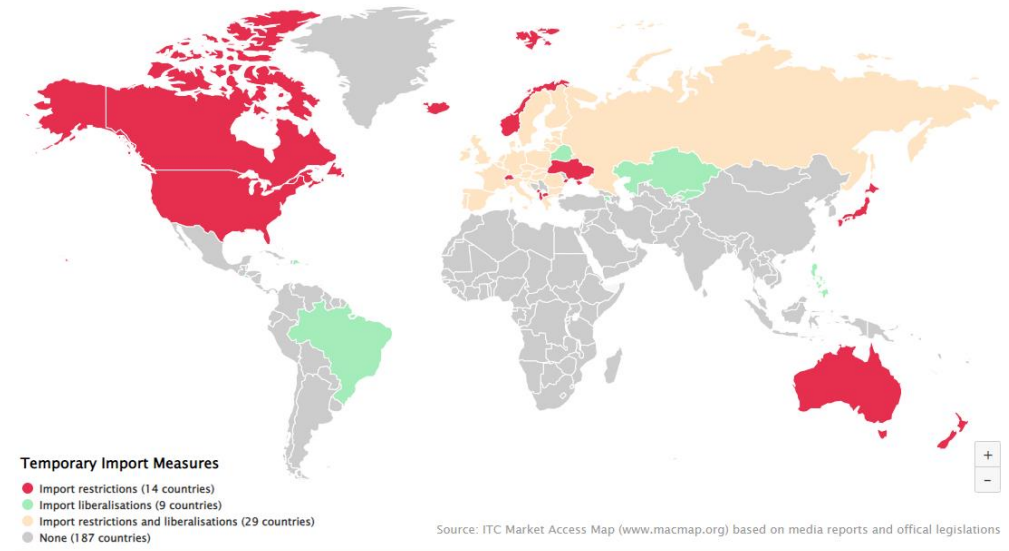
May 2022

This bulletin shows Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine, governments are enacting temporary trade measures as part of economic sanctions and counter-sanctions packages. The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.

Export prohibition	medical, vehicle, agricultural, and electrical equipment	The ban covers exports of telecoms, medical, vehicle, agricultural, and electrical equipment, as well as some forestry products such as timber. 48 countries will be affected, including the US, EU, and other countries as specified.	Restrictive	as specified	Active	11/03/2022	31/12/2022
Export prohibition	sunflower and rapeseed seeds	On April 1, a ban will be imposed on the export of sunflower and rapeseed seeds until August 31, 2022.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	01/04/2022	31/08/2022
Licensing, permit or registration requirements to export	wheat, rye, barley, maize, sugar	March 31, 2022: The ban on the export of wheat seeds, meslin, rye and barley, as well as corn, will be lifted. Their export is allowed to the EAEU countries with a permit issued by the Ministry of Agriculture. March 15, 2022: Russia temporarily banned grain and suger exports to some countries to protect the domestic food market in the face of external constraints. The measure is will remain in place until June 30/August 31 2022.	Restrictive	EAEU and other countries	Active	15/03/2022	31/08/2022

Measures on re-export	medical devices	The Russian Federation established a temporary ban on export from medical devices manufactured in foreign countries that have decided to introduce restrictive economic measures. The measure is applied previously imported products into the Russian Federation from the territory of such foreign countries.	Restrictive	as specified	Active	06/03/2022	31/12/2022
Export quotas	sunflower oil, seed cake,	From April 15, the authorities will introduce a quota for the supply abroad of sunflower oil and cake, as well as solid residues from sunflower seeds. A volume limit of 1.5 million tons is set for oil, and 700 thousand tons for cake. The quota will also be valid until August 31.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	15/04/2022	31/08/2022
Requirement to pass through specified port	soybean	The number of checkpoints for the export of soybean legumes and soybean meal from Russia will be limited. They can be exported only through points located in the Far Eastern Federal District.	Restrictive	All countries	Active	01/04/2022	31/08/2022

Additional tariff	sunflower meal, oilseed flax	From May 1 to August 31, 2022, duties are imposed on the export of sunflower meal and oilseed flax from Russia outside the EAEU. The duty of oilseed flax will be 20 percent, but not less than \$ 100 per ton.	Restrictive	Non-EAEU countries	Active	01/05/2022	31/08/2022
Export prohibition	natural gas	Russia's Gazprom to halt gas supplies to Poland and Bulgaria.	Restrictive	Bulgaria, Poland	Active	26/04/2022	Unknown

Prohibition for political reasons (embargo)	food products	Russia imposed the foodstuffs embargo via presidential decree dated August 6, 2014, against countries that had introduced or supported sanctions against Russia. The measure has since been renewed (20 September 2021) and extended.	Restrictive	as specified	Active	06/08/2014	Unknown
