



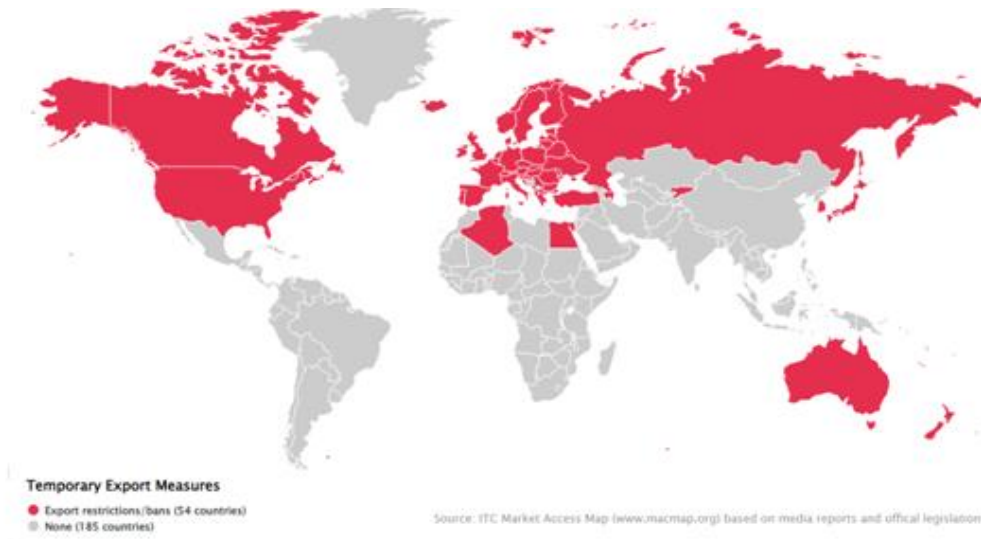

Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine

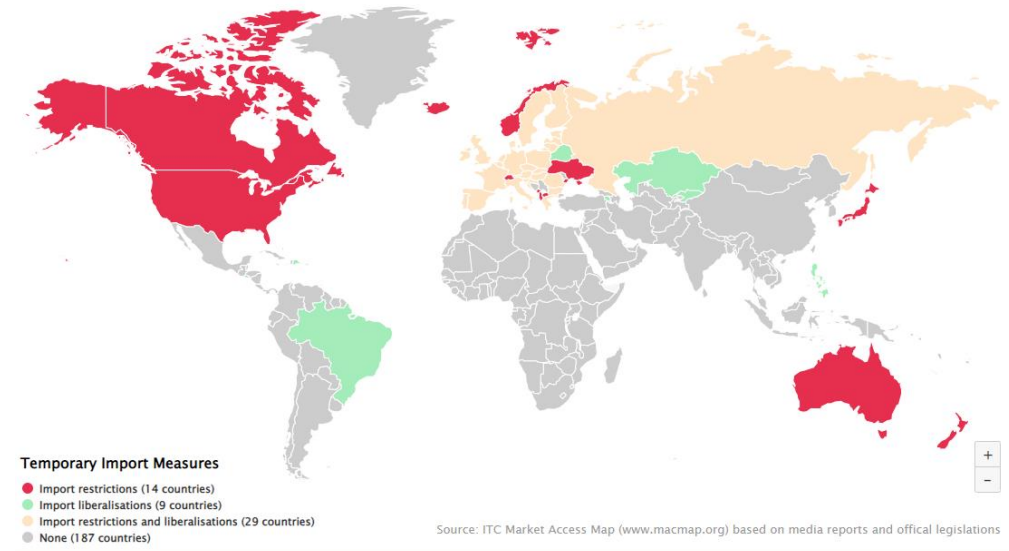
May 2022

This bulletin shows Trade Measures adopted in response to the war in Ukraine, governments are enacting temporary trade measures as part of economic sanctions and counter-sanctions packages. The rapid destabilization in the region has further led to export restrictions in vital products, such as food and fertilizers, by several countries.

Export prohibition	computers, semiconductors, machinery, fuel products	On April 13, 2022, the Federal Council decided to adopt the 5th round of EU export sanctions against Russia.	Restrictive	Russia	Active	13/04/2022	Unknown

Export prohibition	military goods, technology, tobacco products, banknotes	On March 16, 2022, the Federal Council decided on a total revision of the Ordinance on measures against Belarus. The newly adopted measures relate in particular to goods and finance. The sale, supply, export, and transit of armaments of all kinds, including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment, paramilitary equipment and components, accessories, and spare parts therefor, technology, and banknotes to Belarus or for use in Belarus is prohibited. Export prohibition	luxury goods as specified	The sale, supply, export, transport and transit of luxury goods as defined in Annex 18 to any person, company or entity in the Russian Federation or for use in the Russian Federation is prohibited.	Restrictive	Russia	Active	25/03/2022	Unknown

Export prohibition	banknotes	On April 27, 2022, the Federal Council decided to amend the ordinance on measures against Belarus. The ban on the export of banknotes and the sale of securities to Belarusian nationals or persons or entities resident in Belarus are extended to all official currencies of the EU Member States. So far, securities and banknotes in Swiss francs and euros have been affected (the same measure is also planned for Russia).	Restrictive	Belarus	Active	27/04/2022	Unknown
